Message from Auxiliary Madam President

Having a great summer?

Remember on your vacations to save all the extra soaps, shampoos and lotions for the Auxiliary. We use them for the Union Gospel Mission and the Simonka Place (Women and Children's Shelter). These are the ongoing charities we work with throughout the year.

Our own Past State Madam President, Fran Green, is our Chairman for the August charity, Diabetes.

In 1952 when Cal Emmis could not find a camp where his diabetic son could go to, he founded Gales Creek Camp. The camp runs from June 19th through July 31st with volunteer doctors, nurses and dietitians at the camp. Over 400 children come to the camp each year to learn the basic skills on how to deal independently with their Type 1 diabetes, with blood testing and how to administer their insulin.

Gales Creek Camp is the only diabetic camp for children in the Pacific NW. The camp is funded by donations and receives no federal or state funds. Our donations help pay for the children who cannot afford to pay for camp. They do not turn a child away for lack of funds. The cost for children from kindergarten to 11th grade is \$375. A larger fee for parents who wish to be with their kindergartners.

Fran has been working with Gales Creek Camp since 1998. Several members of the Auxiliary spent the day at Gales Creek to gain the Camp experience. It is a beautiful camp in the woods in W Hillsboro. The food was exceptional and targeted to diabetic diets. Many of us wanted to sign up.

For the next year Fran is the State Chairman for Muscular Dystrophy (MD). The Auxiliary has designated the month of May to MD to support her.

So many functions to follow in September for the President's charity, Central Oregon Veteran's Ranch. Watch for fliers to announce the happenings. October is Jimmy Durante Children's Charity, Linda Beerbower, Chairman and November is Alhemizers, Burna McStacy, Chairman. I will keep you posted on the updates.

One day as I was leaving, I walked by the newspaper disposal structure and noticed a man lying in it. I couldn't tell by looking at him, if he was even breathing, so I went back into the building to find someone to help. The sleeper was snoring by the time we got back to check on him, but we had to wake him up in case someone brought newspaper donations, to keep him safe. Do unto others...

We are a People Helping People organization. We collect various hygiene items and donate them to the Union Gospel Mission. These are the items we donate: Hand towel, Wash cloth, Tooth brush, Tooth paste, Comb, Disposable razor, Single size Kleenix tissues, and Shampoo, Conditioner, Hand cream, etc. Bar soap, Hand lotion, and any other hygiene items like samples from motels. If you have any of these items, please consider donating them to our cause.
