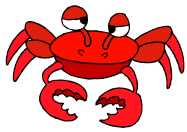
Our Worthy State President, Anthony

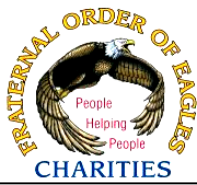
