
Madam President

The Aerie Secretary Offices is receiving Aerie Application that are not filled out properly. <u>YOU NEED</u> to get all the candidates information. Make sure you can read what the candidate wrote because if you can't read it the secretary can't read it either. <u>YOU NEED</u> to fill out the First Proposer information <u>completely</u> if you don't put your Grand Aerie ID number in that means you don't carry your Official Receipt with you. <u>YOU MUST</u> carry your Official Receipt with you to be in the Lodge. <u>YOU MUST</u> have a second Proposer, they need to fill out <u>completely</u> their section. Then the candidate needs to fill out the back side of the application.

When you receive their money for the Initiation fee and dues. Go to the bar and have the bartender write a receipt for the money and give the application, receipt and money.

Aerie Brothers we are in need of a Membership Committee and a Interview Committee. The Membership Committee needs 3 or more Brothers and one chairperson. The Membership Committee explains to the candidate what the Eagles organization is about, the charity work we do, our different committees, puts on events to bring in new members and advertises through social media, discounts on hotels and motels, hearing aids, office Depot & Office Max. The committee make sure that the application is filled out properly. The Interview Committee needs 3 or more Brothers and one chairperson. This committee Interview the candidates to make sure they are a good fit for our lodge. We have a list of questions to ask each candidate that is provided to us from Grand Aerie. The Interview Chairperson brings to the floor the candidates names to be voted on. Brothers we need these two committees filled immediately. We need to build our membership back up to a good level to support our lodge. We need to be in compliance with the Grand Aerie Constitution and Statutes.
