

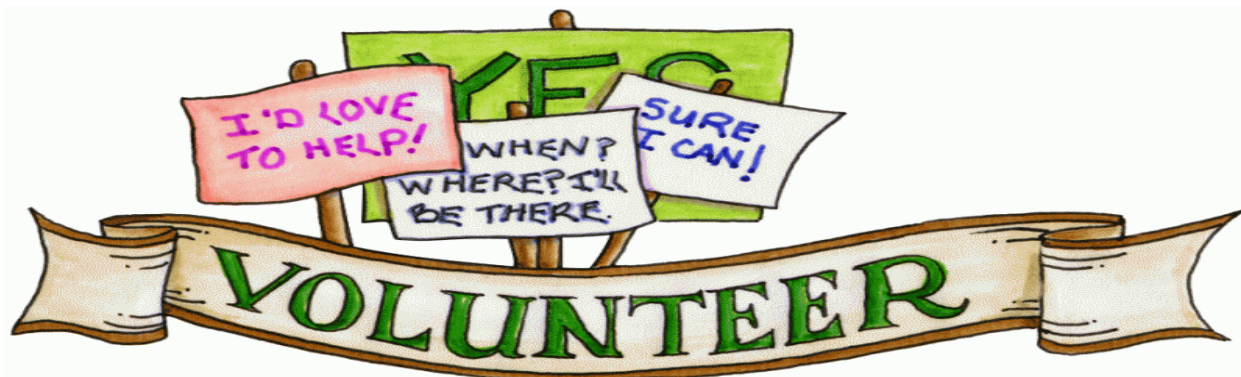

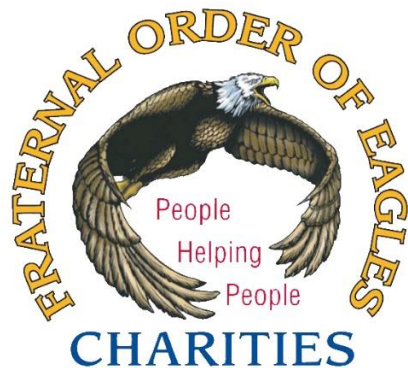

What is a PFO? PFO is a separate organization from the Fraternal Order of Eagles. They are not affiliated in anyway with the Oregon Eagles or Grand Aerie. Their only purpose is to gather information from you and tally it as needed as proof of charity work to the Oregon Legislature

Each year between June 1, to May 15, we turn in volunteered hours, miles driven, money or items donated to be calculated by the PFO Board and present them to the Legislature. These items help keep all Fraternal Orders of Eagles in a non-profit status. Below are some "Volunteer Guidelines". Here is what helps for PFO. Remember you must volunteer and cannot receive any type of payment.

Aerie/Auxiliary Functions

Fraternal Order of Eagles 2021 State Convention New New Guest Book rules, Lottery machines and purchasing from IRS

The word has come down that IRS is in the process of doing audits of many Fraternal Orders this year. We have had some in the Eagles already.

Three areas that IRS has been looking at is the Guest book, lottery machines and purchasing. We now have two guest books. One is for guest from other Eagles and the other is for non-Eagle members. Please make sure your guest is signing the right book. Each guest may visit 3 times and after the third time they **MUST** become a member. Remember Your family members are guest and must sign the non-member book. The books are marked to which one they need to sign. The reason that we must make sure our guest sign the guest book is that IRS is now taxing for each non-member Eagle that visits.

Second is that non-members can not play the lottery. You will notice signs on the machines.

Third, non-members cannot purchase anything at the bar. We have to post a sign there as well.
