# **NEW TO THE EAGLES**



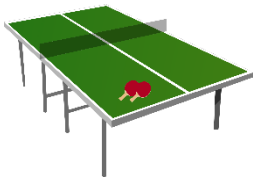
We have a touch screen with games in the Lottery Room. You do have to pay to play. We get a commission off the game just like Lottery.
