Special Packet Buy in is \$15.00 for 1 packet of 6 cards per sheet - 10 games total, 1 packet of 3 cards per sheet - 10 games total and 1 black out card

Extra black out cards are \$1.00 each

Daubers all colors \$2.00 each or bring your own

Black out ball will start at 48 balls drawn and progress one ball every Monday until the pot is won

Only one person per packet. Two people may not play the same packet

BINGO is not open to the public currently. You may bring a visitor up to 3 times after the third time they need to be signed up as a member.

Children are welcome to play. Parents must collect the winnings for their children. (Department of Justice Rules)
