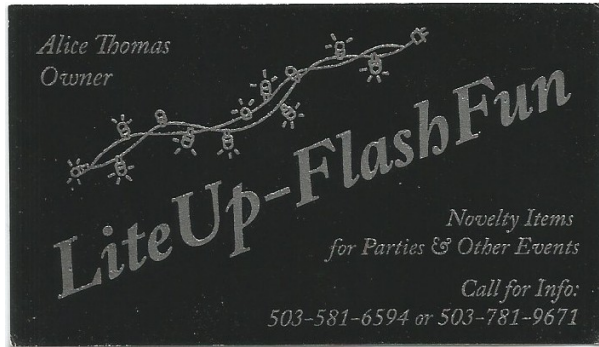
There will be dancing on Friday and Saturday night!
