Update on cashing checks from our bank

Willamette Aerie can no longer accept check that the "PAY TO THE ORDER OF" line is not filled out as follows:

"FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES WILLAMETTE AERIE 2081"

I would like to remind everyone in the "Aerie 2081 House Rules" about checks cashing

3. Checks will only be accepted for payment of annual dues and special ticketed events authorized by the Board of Trustees.

These are true and not rumors

Yes, we have had counterfeit money come into the Aerie. Please bring in smaller bills. All money will be checked with a counterfeit pen to make sure the bills are real. Which means slower services at the bar and diner. The Aerie can not afford to lose money on counterfeit bills.

Yes, the Aerie Secretary has received checks that have come back to the Aerie with insufficient funds from the bank, which costs the Aerie \$22.00 for each check returned. Starting now any check that are used to paid Initiation Fees/Dues with will need to clear the bank before you will see your "Official Receipt".

A reminder that we have a ATM Machine in the Lottery Room. When you ask to get cash off your Debit Card at the bar it shorts the Trustees the next day to have enough cash for the cash registers. Please be helpful and use the ATM Machine.




Queen of Hearts Update and Changes


