Building Sales Update from Pam Rushing

We just did an email blast to over 100 brewerys as well as sent it back out to brokers and other landlords. We have started making cold calls to all the brewerys that received the emails as well as others that we didnt have email addresses for. I did have one group that is talking it over. It is actually three different brewerys that would partner to purchase the building, but they have not really made up their minds what they are going to do.

Hopefully with this blast email and then the follow up calls we will get some more interest.

Year End Financials

The Lodge had positive income for the 2nd year in a roll. The Board would like to thank all members that help made this happen. Now for the detail & analysis of P&L numbers from Quickbooks.

As you see by the above numbers from 2007-2014 we lost \$178,544.00, I not believe that is an accurate number, I know lodge is losing money but not \$178K.

I know that we have paid on the average about \$800.00 per month to have the accounting done. I also know that most Secretary's / Trustee's. Do not know a credit from a debit or what is COS, with that said I will push forward on something needs to be said but I really not want to, but it needs to be said. The last time we paid for a secretary assistant (bookkeeper) cost was \$800.00 per month so I will use that number. Starting June 2014 with the secretary approval I start the process of fixing the P&L and doing the bookkeeping. Along with that lodge stop paying for secretary assistant (bookkeeper). That alone save lodge \$9,600.00 in 2014-2015 if you were to add the cost back in profit would have been (\$1,298.00). In 2015-2016 we had \$19,840.00 in profit, again the lodge did not pay to have the accounting done, that save the lodge \$9,600 again. If you were to add the cost back in the profit would have been \$10,240,

In the last the 2 years profit together is \$28,142.00 in that number is about \$19,200.00 of saving because we do not pay to have the accounting done. Add the cost back in the profit would have been \$8,942.00 2/3 of the profit for that last 2 years have come from not having to pay to have the bookkeeper. I know the some people do want me to do the bookkeeping, **this for the people that believe I should not be doing this task**, **in the bank sit about \$19,000 (that's a huge number)** from the direct work that I have done in the last two years. It's takes about 15 hrs per week that's about 1,500 hrs in the last two years. If you can and want to this task as I have without pay I will go fishing. The only problem is that is I really don't fish. This not meant to mean, it's just that some people just don't have clue.

Keizer Building

I still get members wanting to sell the Keizer building and lock the money down.

Here's your Info. She has leases this property for about five years now.

PGN leases the building for \$2000.00 per month with option to buy for \$400K and she pays all the taxes & repairs. Building cost us about \$280 a year for the fire line. None of the lease payment goes towards the option to buy, and she is the listing real estate agent if we are to list or sell the property.

Land / Building are worth 400-500k land is worth more than the building.

She has paid about \$150K in lease payments; if she were to buy property at 400k we would make 550k off the property. The assets are locked down. Have to go the membership to use any of it. Better than a bank.

We get \$2000 a month on piece of property at time we could only sell for about \$350K, and was costing this lodge \$1,700 a month sitting empty.

Of the \$150K she has paid in lease payment we have used all of it to support this lodge. This has been a steady income stream for this lodge, I believe if was not for this deal we might not be here today.

Once the property is sold that's the end of the revenue stream.
