My Eagles card #2081 has a sticker on it "MEMBER 44 YEARS" and on the card it says "MEMBER SINCE 1972."

My first encounter with #2081 was meeting "SLIM" the manager/president, who was leaving membership applications for the Salem Police Department, Marion County Sheriff's Department and the Oregon State Police .He said because of our occupations, he thought we might encounter unwanted contact when off duty while socializing in restaurants and lounges. He said the Eagles membership was a notch above the normal and would not tolerate this conduct. He invited all to the Eagles as his guests for a tour and answer any questions. Five or six deputies took him up on his offer. During our tour he made a statement that stuck in my mind. *The Eagles lodge can not survive on membership dues alone and the dining room and lounge helps to pay the employees. The events and entertainment for our members and guests come at a minimal additional cost. The ladies/women Auxiliary and the volunteers are the backbone of the lodge.*

Slim was correct- In the last 44 years I have not witnessed or been approached by an unwanted, slobbering drunk, baggy panced gang member or unruly conduct. The people that I have met are the finest people in the world. I am ashamed and embarrassed that I am guilty of never having volunteered. I have donated food and donated items for auction and have been involved in the auctions.

The past officers, employees and volunteers have done an outstanding job overseeing and organizing a very well run lodge and have done this on a less than adequate budget.

The Sixty Dollars (\$60) a year dues amounts to 16.43 cents a day for access for approximately 365 days a year. Enter anytime it is open you are greeted by a staff or volunteer. The lights are always on. It is warm in the winter and cool in the summer and a beautiful building and you feel and I are safe and secure. Our Class A lounge, dining room, television, pool tables, lottery machines and comradery for 16.43 cents a day. The entertainment, Quality music, plays, country dancing, line dancing, ballroom dancing and karaoke and bingo. It comes at a very minimal cost. If you were to outline what we have in this lodge to a business minded person, they would suggest a fee of Sixty Dollars a month which would be two dollars a day. Not Sixty Dollars a year or 16.43 cents a day.

I have witnessed members complaining and refusing to pay Three dollars extra for dancing and quality live music. Most of us have been involved in, owned or managed a business in our lives, hat will attest to the cost of running a business like this lodge.

We have exceptional employees (staff), auxiliary and volunteers that I do not get enough credit. For waiting on us, serving us and making us feel special. One thing I would suggest would be for all workers to be identified with their name and volunteer/auxiliary on a name tag, so they can be properly thanked.

NOW: My suggestions:

On Wednesday night when we are dancing to quality live music that an entry fee at the door should be eight dollars (\$8) per person. That will include a token which will not have a dollar value, but is worth only one of the following at the bar: 1) one bottle of water 2) one soft drink 3) one glass of wine 4) one bottle/can of beer 5) one well drink. The tokens will only be valid for 30 days and cannot be accumulated. Those of us who have danced elsewhere to live music expect to pay \$5 to \$6 dollars and only have access to water and punch.

It is one of the hardest things to do to take away something that has been free or under priced and ask for reasonable compensation. This is a business and we MUST support it or the end result can be to shut the doors- like the Keizer Eagles. A few pennies to us will be dollars well spent in the lodge. I hope we can show our love and support for Salem Eagles #2081.

Let's give our new officers a fighting chance. This may sound like a guilt trip for me, but I feel and have talked to others who agree that it is the right thing to do.
