Water / Bottle water:

If you are eating in the dining room water comes with your meal.

Free Drink Tickets:

Start Nov 1st, expired ticket will no longer be accepted.

Door cards/ buzz in:

Building Sale:

At this time, we have no offers on the building. The last offer was for \$1,250,000.

Offer was too low; Trustee's would like to get \$1.5 Mil for the building.

The finances of the lodge:

We average about 47K total (all bank accounts) per month for the year. Not losing money, but not making much either.

Year to date ending Sept. 2016 profit is about \$4,000.00 that about \$1,000 per month

Not enough to fix the roof or carpets.

We have less than 500 aerie members; this lodge needs about 800 members for this building.

It cost about \$325.00 per day just for overhead for this lodge.
