This year the Eagles Auxiliary President worked with a team to pick the Central Oregon Veterans Ranch (COVR) as the charity the auxiliary will support for the year. They found a 19-acre self-sustaining ranch that restores purpose and spirit to veterans of all ages. A community where veterans help veterans, where a sense of trust and belonging is found. The ranch is located 7 miles south of Redmond and 9 miles north of Bend.

When the VA tells people they are broken, can't work, need to be medicated and institutionalized they are often left with nowhere to go. COVR strives to pick up from that point to develop mutually beneficial relationships between younger veterans and the elderly. In addition, there is medical help for PTSD for those struggling with finding meaning, purpose and self-worth. For those at the end of their service, they also will have Hospice.

On September 1, 2016, several items will be placed in the glass case in the lobby to be raffled off. The Auxiliary will be at functions throughout the month of September to sell you tickets for these items. The tickets will be drawn on October 1, 2016, at the Presidents birthday party at 7 p.m. Come in with a gift for the Ranch and get a piece of birthday cake and dance to band at 8.
